COVID-19 Screening Process

We must treat any fever as if it is COVID related. Therefore, all campers in the carpool will be treated as a close contact. The camper with the fever will require a Doctor's diagnosis stating that it is safe for them to return to camp. If it is COVID related ALL campers in carpool must adhere to CDC guidelines: 14 day self-quarantine. If it is determined that it is NOT COVID related, all campers in carpool may return the following day.

Please be aware of these guidelines as you make carpool arrangements:

COVID Fever guidelines: must be fever free 72 hours without fever-reducing medication before returning to camp.

Basic Communicable Disease Fever guidelines: must be fever free 24 hours without fever-reducing medication before returning to camp.
